All competitors compete absolutely at their own risk; waiver forms to be signed on entering. All handlers, riders and exhibitors to be current members of the Mundulla Show Society.

Please Note – due to the event being held on the lower oval, horse floats need to enter via Mile Lane Gate. **See Map provided.**

The Society is affiliated with the RA&HS and their rulings will apply.

Ring 1: If competitors are registered with EA / SHC SA, numbers and horses' names to be shown on the entry form.

Horses to be entered in the bona fide names of their owner.

Riding helmets and boots must be worn by anyone riding a horse on the grounds. Helmets must be approved under the current Australian Standard.

Rings will not be held for competitors.

Stallions must be 'bitted' while competing and must be handled by a person 18 years or over.

Horses to be shown as hack or hunter, not both.

Riders who compete in Ring 1 Open are ineligible to compete in Encourage or Ring 3 but may compete in Led and OTT section.

Riders who compete in Walk/Trot classes are ineligible to compete in any Walk/Trot/Canter classes and vice versa.

Dogs to be on a leash at all times.

No lunging on the oval. Refer to map for warm up areas.

Grounds to be clean of manure and holes to be filled in.

The Mundulla Show Society will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to rider, property or mount.

All classes will be judged on the circle, aside from Championships.

This ring is designed for those who may:

- want to have a go but are unsure how it all works
- just want to have fun with their horse and a bit of a laugh
- like to take their horse out but aren't ready to join the big rings
- feel intimidated competing with people who have been to a lot of shows or might not be confident at all gaits (or any)

During the program, the judge will explain each class, it's requirements and what they are looking for (or other judges may look for). Entrants can ask as many questions as they like of either the judge or the steward on the day.

Participants/Riders must be over 14 years old and you know what, if you want to be Led by your parent, that is just fine.

In the interest of maintaining a welcoming environment for all, there is NO plaiting allowed and no make up for horses (you don't have to wear any either 😊). You don't even have to wash your horse, just give it a nice brush and get out there!

No fancy clothes required. Entrants can wear jeans/jodhpurs/long pants and shirts/tshirts.

Led entrants must have closed in shoes (no hats required). Ridden entrants must have suitable boots and helmets.

Any tack is allowable for the horse – as long as it fits your horse correctly.

Participants/riders must choose between **NEWBIE** OR **NOVICE** you cannot enter both.

NEWBIE (We've never done this before) – Combination has not competed together previously.

NOVICE (This isn't our first rodeo) – Combination has not competed together prior to AUGUST 2023.

Consideration will be given to those wishing to enter but do not meet these requirements – ie returning to riding post injury/fall and looking to gain confidence – feel free to contact Ring Steward Elle Petersen to discuss.

Participants/riders must choose Walk only or Walk / Trot – you cannot enter both, it's not fair 😊

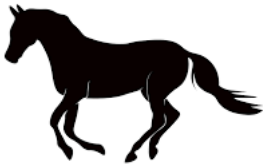

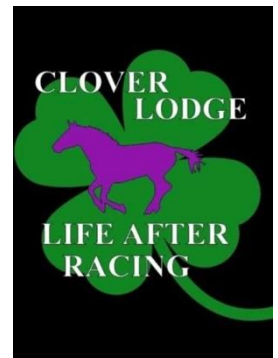
