BOOKING FORM

The Mundulla Show, through ASA grant funding, purchased a trailer and items needed to make running our Young Farmer's Challenge (YFC) easier. It was purchased with the aim of it being used at other shows, particularly in the South East.

A hiring fee of **\$50** to help cover the cost of the registration, general maintenance and repairs as well as the purchase of additional challenge items.

Damage to the trailer or items as a direct result of the running of the challenge are to be covered by the hiring show society. Show societies are also welcome to add items to the trailer if they wish.

The trailer is looked after by Brody Lock and Lachy Johnson who also, depending on availability, can help transport the trailer and aid in the running of the event. Other South East Rural Ambassadors have also in recent years been involved with the running of YFC events at different Shows, so there is a pool of people able to give advice and potentially help if available.

It is advised, that shows wishing to run a YFC appoint a convenor/coordinator to organise the event. It is then their responsibility to get in touch to make plans for getting the trailer to and from the venue. This may be a good job for current, past and even future rural ambassador/s of your show.

When transporting the trailer, a registered and insured vehicle of a suitable size must be used. The driver must hold a valid license and their details included in the application below.
